Fund Name Changes; New Fund Has Launched

Effective on or about April 1, 2016, American Funds has changed the name of its money market fund and introduced a new flexible-core bond fund.

American Funds Money Market Fund® American Funds Money Market Fund was renamed American Funds U.S. Government Money Market FundSM.

In addition to the name change, the fund increased its investment in qualifying government securities to meet the standards of a government money market fund. The impact to the fund's investment strategy should be minimal, since the current money market fund already invests primarily in U.S. government securities.

The changes to the money market fund were in response to amendments adopted in July 2014 by the U.S. Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC). These amendments impose new requirements on money market mutual funds.
