## Money Market Concentration Policy Change and Name Change

Effective December 1, 2015, the funds in the attached chart will be renamed and have a policy change, as approved by the funds' Board of Trustees and fund shareholders. The change will enable each fund to operate as a government money market fund. Each fund will implement the following changes:

- The funds will no longer be required or permitted to invest more than 25% of total assets in securities issued by the financial services industry.
- Adopt a principal investment strategy to normally invest at least 99.5% of the fund's total assets in cash, U.S. Government securities and/or repurchase agreements that are collateralized fully (i.e., collateralized by cash or government securities) (ii)
- Change name to reflect each fund's transition to a government money market fund.
- Adopt disclosure stating that each fund will not impose liquidity fees or redemption gates.

The chart below lists the current name and the new one for each of these funds.
