As noted in our previous communications, Invesco Ltd. ("Invesco") and Massachusetts Mutual Life Insurance Company have entered into a definitive agreement, whereby Invesco will acquire OppenheimerFunds, Inc. This transition is tentatively expected to occur over the Memorial Day weekend, May 25<sup>th</sup> through the 27<sup>th</sup>, 2019<sup>\*</sup>.
